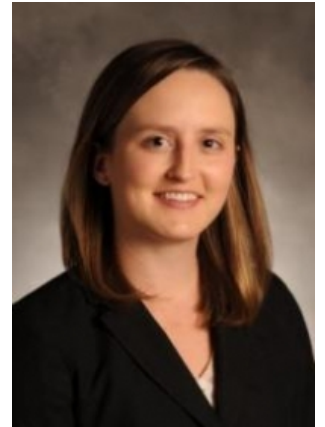
Wyche Expands Its Corporate and Litigation Groups with Three New Associates: David K. Anna, Natalie R. Dunham and Wade S. Kolb III
